I am happy to inform you of our new Family Caregiving program to support safe, meaningful visits.

As our caregiving partners, families -including extended family, friends and neighbours-support resident wellbeing and quality of life, whether during social or care visits.

peopleCare's Family Caregiving Programs were designed to support families and other visitors with a range of options, based on their preferences and the resident's care needs (in alignment with Ministry directives).

To foster a collaborative approach to balancing safety and quality of life, and clarify current directives around visiting during the pandemic, we have created a toolkit of resources that includes a Partners in Care Pledge, an overview of visit types/precautions, and educational videos around correct hand washing and use of PPE. (stay tuned for this package coming soon!)

Changes to Directive #3

As you may have heard, on Friday August 28th the government announced changes to Directive #3 that will allow long-term care residents to leave the Home for short periods of time, including some overnight stays.

We are excited the government is taking this step forward and that residents will soon have this opportunity to leave the Home if they wish to do so, for social and other reasons.

peopleCare's goal is to ensure the safety of our residents, staff and families at all times. In the next few days we will take time to carefully plan how we can work together to support these absences in the safest possible way.

As we finalize our plans, we will have more information to share with everyone early this week around next steps.

In the meantime, please be assured that all COVID precautions remain in place in the Home, and we continue to focus on making every day a good day for our residents and staff.

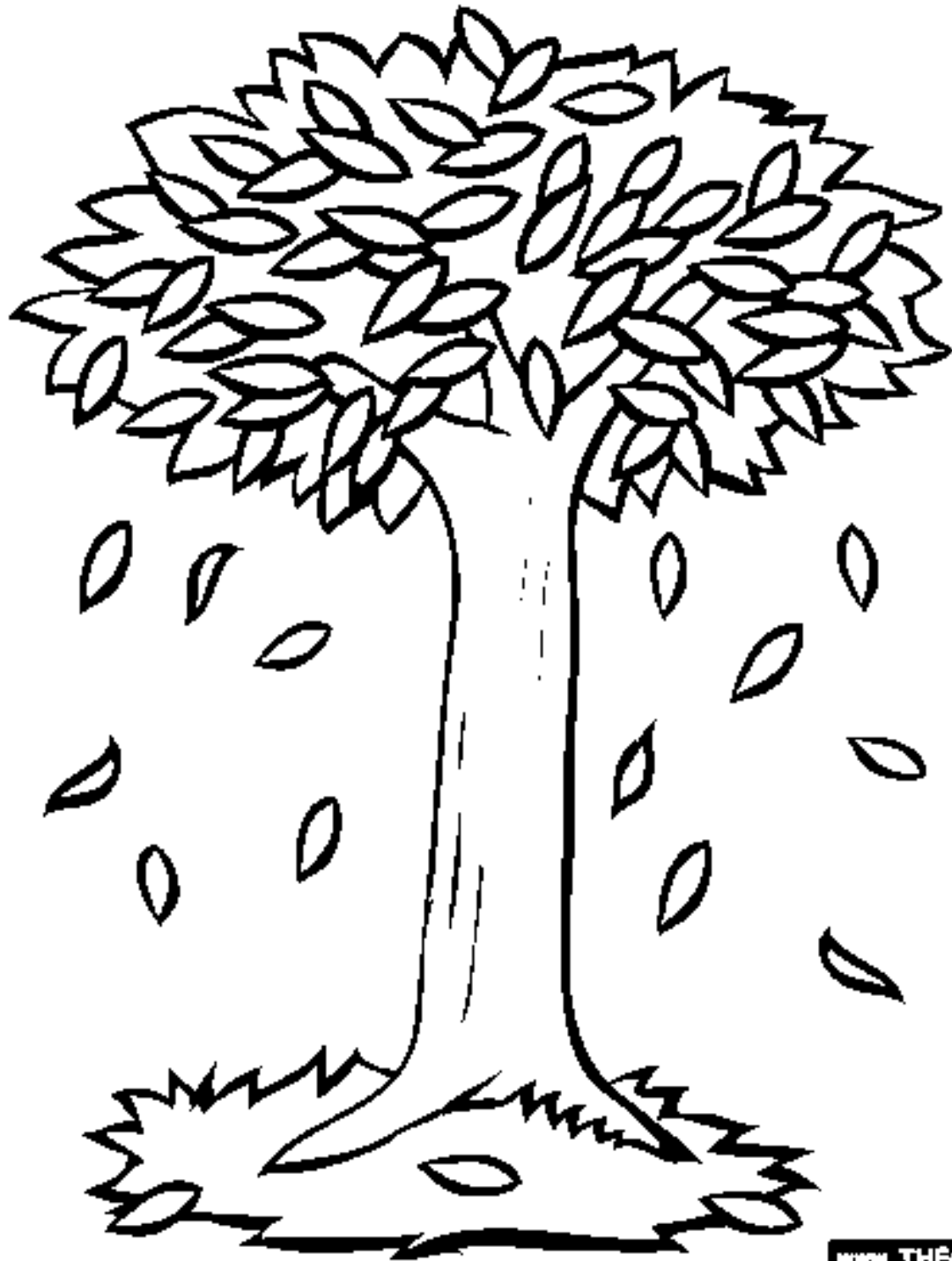
