Keep up to date with all things IPAC in the newsletters and in the home!

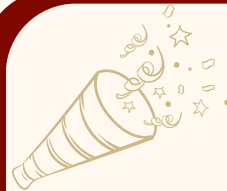

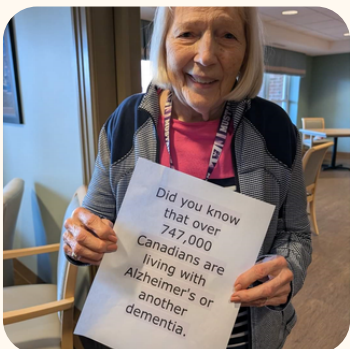
