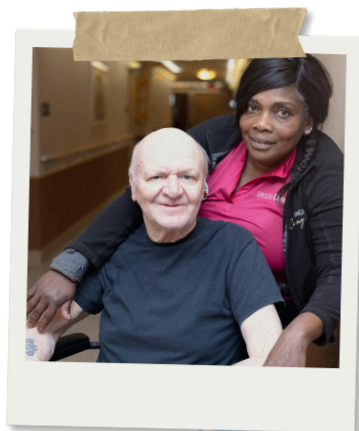

## LETTING PEOPLE OUTSIDE

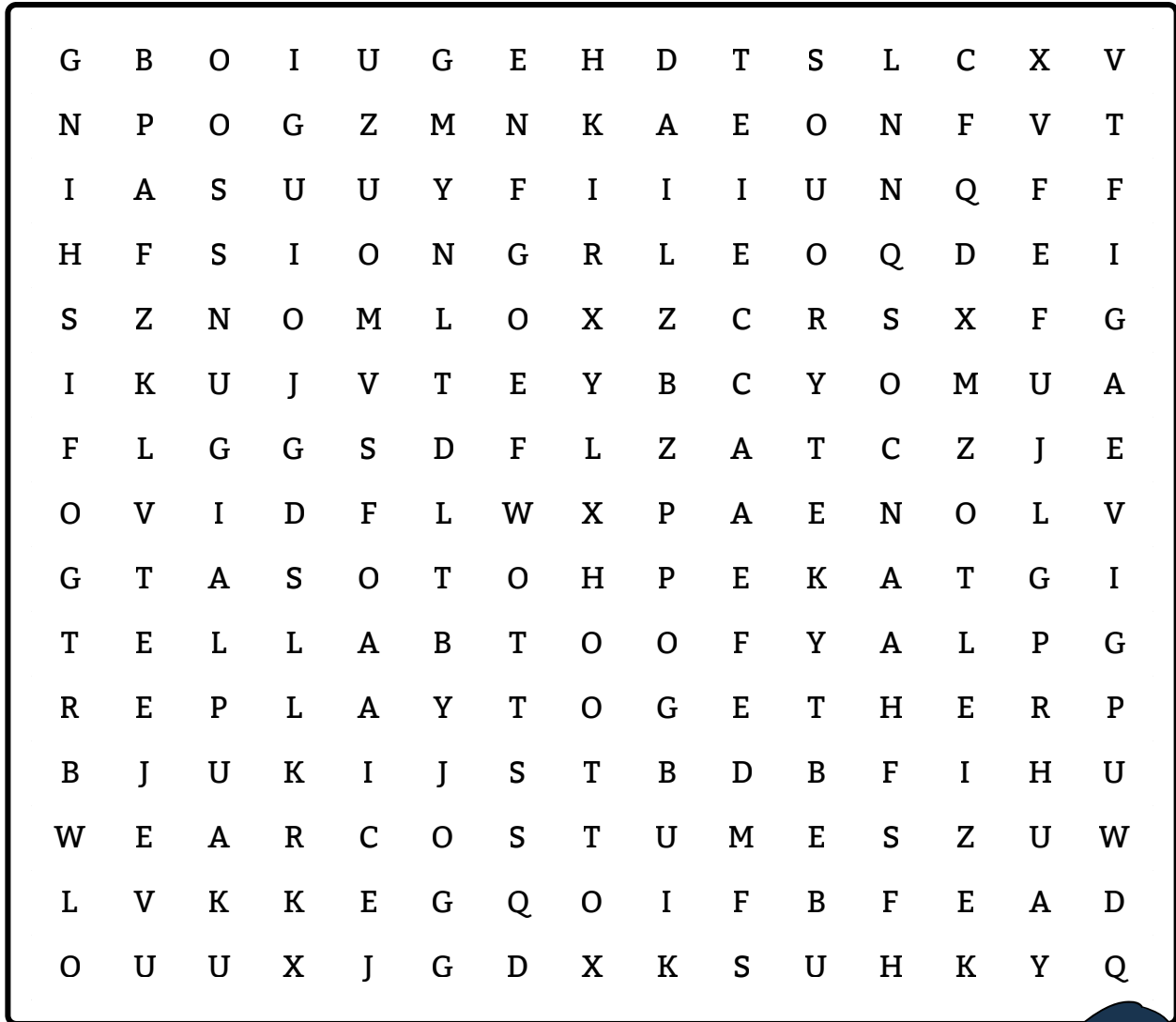
